EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 014-2020

AN ORDER ADOPTING SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES FOR THE PREVENTION AND MITIGATION OF TRANSMISSION OF COVID-19

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 922 signed by President Duterte on 08 March 2020 "DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES" amid DOH Secretary has confirmed the local transmission of Corona Virus Disease (Covid-19) in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the declaration of a State of Public Health Emergency would capacitate government agencies and LGUs to immediately act to prevent loss of life, utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of Covid-19, mitigate its effects and impact to the community and prevent serious disruption of the functioning of the government and the community;

WHEREAS, all government agencies and LGUs are hereby enjoined to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the Covid-19 threat;

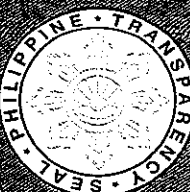
NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAIME V. CAPIL, Municipal Mayor of Porac, Pampanga, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order to implement the following supplemental guidelines for Prevention and Mitigation of Transmission of Covid19;

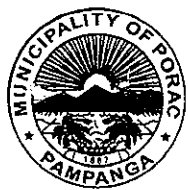
1. The municipality with the assistance of the Porac PNP, BFP and AFP must established checkpoints in the following barangay boarders:
 - Brgy. Sta Cruz (Porac – Angeles)
 - Brgy. Pulong Santol (Porac – Sta. Rita)
 - Brgy. Planas (Porac – Floridablanca)
 - Brgy. Calzadang Bayu (Porac – Bacolor)
 - Brgy. Calzadang Bayu (Megadike)
 - Brgy. Salu (Porac – Guagua)
- 1.1 The checkpoints must ensure the unrestricted movement of frontline workers and goods. Decontamination area must be setup to all checkpoints identified above in coordination with Porac BFP, MDRRMO and Engineering Office. Thermal scanners must be used to all individuals entering the municipality and those with greater than 37.8 C temperature must be denied of entry.
2. Each barangay must set-up own checkpoints to allow only those with home quarantine pass to go out to buy essential needs.
3. The municipality through the Human Resource Management Office (HRMO) must formulate Work from Home policies to be issued as supplemental attachment with

this order

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4. All classes both in Public and Private as well as in the College level is suspended until further announcement from the office of the mayor. Likewise, no school activities must be done until the enhanced community quarantine is lifted.
5. The municipality will immediately utilize the Quick Response Funds upon the declaration of State of Calamity to assist the indigent families and daily wage earners.
6. The municipality will issue a separate order for a sound and comprehensive implementation of strict home quarantine. The municipality must continue to monitor the skeletal force and social distancing measure.
7. Only those essential establishments in line with food production, medicine supplies, money remittances and banks must remain in operation. Other businesses not mentioned in this order must discontinue their operation immediately.
8. Mass public transportation will be suspended (Jeepney and Tricycle). The municipality must provide service vehicles to front liners such as nurses, midwives and other health workers to continue the health services to the barangays.
9. The Quick Response Team (QRT) must continue to service constituents needing medical assistance/attention. Barangay service vehicles can also be used as transportation for mild cases.
10. The municipal government must comply with the directive of the Department of Health (DOH) in handling suspected or confirmed COVID-19 patients. The Municipal Health Officer thru the Task Force must provide the guidelines for the adoption of such directives.
11. The municipality of Porac must coordinate with Clark Development Corporation (CDC) and Bases Conversion & Development Authority (BCDA) regarding the use of their facilities as Isolation Units. On the other hand, the LGU must continue to look for Isolation Units within the municipality and execute Memorandum of Agreement as soon as possible.

Repealing Clause. All issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this order are hereby repealed or amended accordingly;

Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately.
